

## Compliance Clause for Business Partners – Supplier

### Compliance

1. The Supplier undertakes to comply with the requirements of our Code of Conduct for Business Partners ([www.bucktonscott.de](http://www.bucktonscott.de)) and the principles of the UN Global Compact Initiative, which essentially concern the protection of international human rights, the abolition of forced and child labour, the elimination of discrimination in employment, and responsibility for the environment ([www.unglobalcompact.org](http://www.unglobalcompact.org)).
2. If an infringement of the obligations under No. 1 is suspected, the Supplier must immediately investigate possible infringements and inform us about the measures that it has taken to do so. If the suspicion proves to be justified, the Supplier must inform us within a reasonable period of time of the internal measures that it has taken to prevent future infringements. If the Supplier fails to meet these obligations within a reasonable period of time, we reserve the right to withdraw from contracts with the Supplier or to terminate these with immediate effect.
3. In the event of serious violations of the law by the Supplier and in the event of serious violations of the provisions of No. 1 and 2, we reserve the right to withdraw from existing contracts or terminate them without notice.
